With support from Safe Kids, the YMCA of Delaware will be hosting an event in June 2016 to distribute about 200 free life jackets to needy children in the community as well as to educate those children on pool safety. In 2015, the YMCA's Learn to Swim Program provided about 4,000 Delaware children with free swim lessons. The

		program has multiple partners including individual schools, the Salvation Army, West End Neighborhood House, and the Latina American Community Center. The programs' largest partnership is with the Red Clay School District which encourages all of their 3 rd graders to learn how to swim.
