CALL TO ORDER

Chairman Roberts called the meeting to order at 9:00 a.m.

PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE

MOMENT OF SILENCE

Chairman Roberts suggested a moment of silence for the fallen Wilmington firefighters. He requested prayers for the family members, Fire Company and for the injured firefighters that remain in the hospital at this time.

APPROVAL OF OCTOBER 18, 2016 COMMISSION MEETING MINUTES

It was moved by Commissioner DiCristofaro, and seconded by Commissioner Zeroles that the minutes of the September 20, 2016 Commission meeting be approved. Motion carried by unanimous vote.

REPORT OF THE STATE FIRE MARSHAL

INFORMATIONAL ITEMS

Personnel Items

The vacant New Castle County Deputy Fire Marshal I position is currently under the background phase.

Fire Marshal Ingle received an eligible list for the Deputy Fire Marshal I position in Kent County. The agency will wait to move forward in the hiring process while two appeals are being processed.

The Fire Inspector (Day Care) position has been posted and closed November 8th. Interviews will be scheduled within the next two weeks.

Stephanie Goodyear has been promoted to Executive Secretary in Kent County as of October 31, 2016. She has been with the agency for over 20 years and has a good working knowledge of the agency. This created an Administrative Specialist I vacancy. The hiring process is underway.

Fire Fatalities

Fire Marshal Ingle reported on a fire fatality that occurred on October 21, 2016 within the Laurel Fire Department district. There was heavy fire when the fire department arrived. The victim was found inside of the structure and there were no smoke alarms in the structure. The incident is currently under investigation. There are 8 fire deaths in 2016. Five are without working smoke alarms and three are with working smoke alarms.

FY' 18 Public Budget Hearing

The Office of State Fire Marshal will request maintaining the budget as in FY' 17.

DTI Update

Fire Marshal Ingle is waiting on a start date for new vendor written software. It should begin by December or January and be completed within six months.

EDIS Regulation Presentation

Fire Marshal Ingle received a request from contracting firm EDIS for a regulation presentation by his staff. The presentation reviewed changes made in the regulations and covered mainly Chapter 43 and the Life Safety Code. It was beneficial for the company and the office by working together.

Proposed Regulation Changes

In accordance with the 2015 Delaware State Fire Prevention Regulations, Regulation 701, Chapter 1, 4.0 Review and Updating of Regulations, were reviewed by Fire Marshal Ingle. He found that they are in order with need of a few minor changes. Fire Marshal Ingle provided the commission with a suggested changes.

REPORT OF BLS MEDICAL DIRECTOR

EMS protocols have been approved by ALS standards committee and the BMLD. ALS protocols will be effective November 1, 2016 and BLS protocol implementation date is January 1, 2017.

BLS albuterol pilot program: A second abstract regarding the success of the DE albuterol pilot program will be presented in January at the NAESP Conference.

ED trauma designation: NCC Wilmington ED has been granted provisional level 3 trauma center status effective October 5, 2016. CDC guidelines for field triage of injured patients and DE protocols should be followed when determining most appropriate destination for trauma victims. Online medical control should be contacted for appropriate ED preparation. This is the second provisional level 3 trauma center in New Castle County in addition to St. Francis Hospital.

Dr. Matthews reported that 29 companies that carry aspirin with 137 administrations of aspirin. 29 companies carry Albuterol with 184 administrations of Albuterol. 18 companies carry Narcan with 154 administrations. Approximately 18 companies carry the EPI Pen with 4 administrations.

Narcan update – No additional supplies have been donated to the Office of Emergency Medical Services.

Deputy Attorney General Davis updated the Commission on the CFT Ambulance appeal decision that was appealed to Superior Court. The Commission revoked CFT Ambulance License through a hearing process and CFT Ambulance appealed that decision to Superior Court. Superior Court has ruled to uphold the decision made by the Fire Prevention Commission. The time has expired that CFT Ambulance could appeal to the Supreme Court, so this is now the final ruling. Chairman Roberts thanked DAG Davis for her dedicated work in this case.
