## SUMMARY OF DISCUSSION

- The Committee co-Chair provided a recap of the last Payment Committee meeting and updates from the Board
- Representatives from UHC, presented an update on value-based payment rollout including the introduction of two new models for value-based payment
- A representative from Highmark, provided a brief update on value-based payment rollout including the launch of a TruePerformance pilot for Medicaid with 14 practices (~10,000 lives) enrolled and plans to release contracts for commercial plans in January 2017
- A representative from Beebe, updated the Committee on Beebe's decision to not renew contracts with Delmarva Health Network and join Christian Care Quality Partners ACO, effective January 2017
- The Committee discussed recent announcements from CMS detailing markets eligible for CPC+ (Delaware opted out) and the introduction of bundled payments for cardiac care. CMS will randomly select 98 metropolitan markets for participation in cardiac bundles and Delaware is eligible. Final regulation is scheduled to be issued in November
- The Committee discussed the Delaware Health Care Claims Database, which was signed into law in July and will include Medicaid, State employee health plans, and QHPs. A transparency working group will be established to support DHIN on its development of the database

- The Committee discussed the status of the Behavioral Health Integration testing program and the implementation plan approved by the Board
  - Goal of the testing program is to test operational feasibility; the program will also attempt to gather outcomes data
  - Three models will be launched to meet a spectrum of provider needs across a diverse group of practices
  - Telehealth will be encouraged in all three models
  - Participants will be expected to enable data sharing, ideally through some form of EMR integration
  - Committee members may be asked to assist with increasing awareness of the program and securing support from stakeholders
