

NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING BEFORE THE NEIGHBORHOOD BUILDING BLOCKS FUND BOARD

Public Notice is hereby given in accordance with Title 29, Section 10004 of the *Delaware Code*, as amended, 29 *Del. C.* §5005(11), as amended, and Title 1 *Delaware Administrative Code*, Part 479 (18 DE. Reg. 464) (12/01/14) that the Neighborhood Building Blocks Fund Board (the “Board”) with the Delaware Economic Development Office, as the administrator of the Board, will conduct a public hearing on Monday, August 15, 2016 at 1:30 P.M. in the Main Conference Room at the Delaware Economic Development Office, Tenth Floor, 820 North French Street, Wilmington Delaware 19901.

The public meeting will address the matters and applications described below for proposed grants from the Board authorized by §39 of the FY 2015 Budget Act (79 *Del.
