The group reviewed new data including the SAT data.

Discussion: JoAnn will follow up to see if youth who are IV-E eligible can be marked as such on the list of foster care students. JoAnn will follow up with Ty to see if there is a way to track IV-E in a query.

Promoting SAT supports

The group agreed that we need to do more to promote SAT prep among foster families. JoAnn will send out a supplemental back to school letter with the following information:

- Kaplan is a free resource with the foster care parent resource newsletter.
- Home access center. Foster parent needs password and user name.
- SAT prep
- Texting campaign—DOE—monthly reinforcers for college prep.
- Physicals, immunizations
- Reasonable and prudent parent standard: what they can sign for in school.

Joann will get this out by Sept. 15, 2016.

Jenn will also create a foster care website with resources for foster parents and youth.

Student Comprehensive Education Summary:

Michele updated the group that the snapshot is nearing completion. There is a new request to add credits toward graduation, which is tricky but the developers are working on that. The summary should be finished soon and could be live in the fall. Michele will follow up on the Education Summary and follow up on process. Then we will develop a process form and FAQ. Michele explained that this report would be useful for many cases—quick summary report for many issues (prep for an IEP meeting, superintendent notice, disciplinary, attendance, etc.). Eliza will work on draft for FAQ for our September meeting. Jenn will follow up whether the summary can be emailed through regular email or whether it has to be encrypted for security. Jenn will also need to train the foster/homeless liaisons on the Ed Insight Dashboard and access. Finally, Michele will let Chief of Chiefs know the snapshot in

development and when it's ready we will consider getting on the next calendar date to let them know about it and the benefits.
