CORRESPONDENCE

Sean Cummins Letter- Board Members reviewed Mr. Cummins' request for licensure of his employees and determined that they must apply for licensure and meet all requirements as outlined in regulations and statutes, meet all experience requirements. Mr. Cummins requested placement on the agenda for the meeting but did not appear.

OTHER BUSINESS BEFORE THE BOARD

Mr. Mangler addressed the Board regarding complaints made to the Governor's Office concerning allegations of unlicensed electricians actively working in the community and the timeliness of investigation completion. Mr. Mangler discussed the State hiring freeze that was just lifted, vacant positions soon to be filled, diminishing numbers of outstanding investigations and investigation prioritization. Mr. Hartley and Mr. MacLennan commented on their "duty to report" allegations when suspected. DAG Maloney discussed with Board Members that while he understands the ethical standpoint of the "duty to report," their position on the Board places them in a precarious position. They must NOT investigate allegations themselves and remain neutral and recuse themselves from all facets of the investigative process.

PUBLIC COMMENT

Ms. Connie Meyers addressed the Board with her concerns that meetings are taking too long because the Board should be reviewing applicant files prior to the actual meeting rather than during the meeting. Mr. MacLennan explained to Ms. Meyers that the Board does review applications prior to the meeting but it is a necessity for them to confer with other Board Members regarding the actual paperwork at the meeting as an added quality control. Ms. Meyers also commented on the meeting being called to order 15 minutes late. Mr. MacLennan and Mr. Hartley explained that Route 1 was closed outside of Middletown causing delay for members residing/working in New Castle County
