- 3. An opening statement was made by Mr. Hartigan regarding the background of the docket and events to date.
- 4. Participants discussed various issues related to electric choice in Delaware, including:
 - a. implementing a Purchase of Receivables (POR) program
 - b. allowing first-time customers to enroll directly with a third party supplier
 - c. allowing customers who are already enrolled with a third party supplier and move within the Delmarva Power territory to retain that supplier
 - d. the “enroll with your wallet” concept which suppliers contend would allow customers to be more easily enrolled
 - e. the current status of communications options for suppliers on Delmarva Power’s monthly billing statements
 - f. developing an electric supply choice website
 - g. establishing a regular communications process between interested stakeholders
- 5. The following deliverables were agreed to by the participants:
 - a. RESA to file detailed proposal for items ‘a’ through ‘f’ identified above by Sept. 29, 2017. If any supplier disagrees with any part of the RESA proposal the supplier can submit an alternate proposal.
 - b. Interested parties to participate in a teleconference to discuss RESA proposal on Oct. 16, 2017
 - c. Delmarva Power to provide cost estimates for various system changes required to accommodate proposed changes by Nov. 13, 2017
 - d. Interested parties submit comments by Dec. 15, 2017
