MINUTES for August 9, 2018

The DVCC Public/Awareness/Education Committee met on August 9, 2018 at the Leonard L. Williams Justice Center, Wilmington. Attending the meeting were: Hon. Carl Danberg, Chair; Jenn Kutney-Soper - Department of Justice; Katrina Banks – Beautiful Gate Outreach Center; Moe Monagle and Pat Kwetkauskie, DVCC Staff. Janet Coston, Division of Public Health; Regina Johnson- Prevention and Behavioral Health Services (DSCYF) and Zainab Shah – Delaware Coalition Against Domestic Violence participated by telephone.

Call to Order: Judge Danberg called the meeting to order. He noted a quorum was not present.

Minutes: The Minutes from May 10, 2018 will remain posted as draft and voted on at the next meeting.

➤ Update - 2018 Healthy Relationships Poster Contest

There was discussion about expanding the 2018 Poster Contest. The Committee agreed to invite all high school students in Delaware to participate.

The Committee also agreed to use “Respect Every Day ... Every Day” as the theme for the contest.

Next Steps:

DVCC staff will approach award sponsors from last year’s contest to determine their interest in providing awards again this year.

DVCC staff will prepare a flyer and poster entry submission form for the Committee to review.

Once finalized, DVCC staff will distribute cover letters, flyers announcing the Poster Contest and entry submission forms to Directors of High School Art Programs throughout Delaware.

➤ Social Media Campaign

Moe noted that the DCADV and the DVCC will join the national campaign *#1Thing* to help bring awareness and shed light on how one person’s actions combined with others in a whole community can lead to real social transformation. Moe noted we encourage community partners to post videos and pictures to *#1ThingDelaware*.

➤ New Curriculum Obtained

DVCC Staff noted they have obtained four versions of the curriculum “In Her Shoes”. The basic version, one to use with teens, one to use with those who work with teens and a curriculum based on survivors access to social and economic justice.
