Previous Meeting Minutes

Todd Reavis motioned to approve the minutes from the previous meeting on 9/10/18. Mike Mahaffie seconded the motion. All members voted to approve the minutes.

Discuss Open Data Action Plans

- Discussion was held around the accomplishments since the last meeting.
- The FirstMap group has had a challenge in getting PIOs to understand what is available. Maybe we can do a joint presentation to the PIOs. Mike suggests contacting Jon Starkey.
- Data is a raw material, Open Data Portal is a tool/infrastructure to make the data available. The data can be used as a tool to visualize and tell the story about the data. DNREC has talked to other states about this and the federal government.
- We need to evangelize this effort and get enough staff to support this in order to move Open Data forward.
- User group for state agency program people to give them a resource to find out about data, ask questions about data, and understand where to go to get info on data. We need to create a culture of data.

- Business Intelligence tool – Enable this for the state to get more value out of their data.
- Create a Google doc to begin the Open Data Action Plan. Link from the Open Data Council page to view. Create a public comment forum for the Plan.
- Bob has been doing a lot of work with environmental groups at the national level. We should be able to pull ideas to incorporate into our plan. Mike will confer with Bob and send some info to the group.

 - Review and Update the Strategic Plan (continuous)
 - Outreach and Education for state agencies
 - PIO meeting
 - Presentations to leadership in each state agency
