The Division for the Visually Impaired's Joint Finance Committee Hearing was held on February 19, 2019. Although DVI requested funding for Education Services, it did not include resources for Independent Living specifically. DVI is seeking to reallocate administrative costs from the grant to the state. DVI is not hiring for the vacant Vision Rehabilitation Therapist or Administrative Specialist.

There are no updates on the Sunset process.

DVI continues to receive feedback regarding the client satisfaction surveys and is making appropriate adjustments.

Now that the video of the Vocational Rehabilitation program is completed; the next video will feature the Business Enterprise Program.

DVI has developed a new partnership with the Delaware Optometric Association. This will expand membership beyond eye care professionals and provide an additional spectrum for the Division to showcase their services and reach potential individuals with visual obstacles.

All units of the Division with the exception of the Business Enterprise Program, have been working collaboratively to bring a variety of Expanded Core Curriculum programs to their students.
