The Delaware Department of Transportation (DelDOT) in cooperation with Delaware Greenways and their 30th anniversary celebration invites the public to attend a public open house to receive information about the Brandywine Valley National Scenic Byway. Excess parking will be provided at Nemours. The byway management partnership for this byway have drafted their Corridor Management Plan for 2019 to 2029. Interested members of the public are invited to attend and offer input before final sign-off and acknowledgment by DelDOT for the draft plan to occur.

The purpose of the open house and workshop is to provide an opportunity for the public to review and discuss the continuing or new strategies, goals, and objectives of the Brandywine Valley National Scenic Byway. This will ensure that adequate measures and future tasks may be in place with an updated corridor management plan. Attendees will have an opportunity to review display materials and provide comments to DelDOT and byway management representatives. This is an open house forum where attendees can also learn more about the byway and how to become involved.

Interested persons are invited to express their views in writing, giving reasons for support of or in opposition to the Corridor Management Plan 2019-2029.
