Delaware Bayshore Byway Corridor Management Plan 2020

Document Available for Comment (comment period ending 4/24/20)

The Delaware Department of Transportation (DelDOT) in cooperation with Delaware Greenways and the Delaware Bayshore Byway Management and Partnership Team have drafted and updated their Corridor Management Plan (CMP) for 2020 on the Delaware Bayshore Byway. This draft document carries forward the current byway route with inclusion of portions in lower Kent and Sussex County, commonly referred to as the southern corridor extension. Interested members of the public, stakeholders, or other governing entities are invited to way and offer input to ensure adequacy and completeness before final sign-off and acknowledgment by DelDOT of the current drat plan can occur.

The purpose of the public announcement is to provide an opportunity for the public and others to review and discuss the continuing or new strategies, goals, and objectives of the Delaware Bayshore Byway. This will ensure that adequate measures and future tasks may be in place with an applicable and workable corridor management plan for the entire byway designation. The document is a comprehensive planning document that concentrates on describing the ten additional discovery zones situated in Kent and Sussex County. Given the COVID-19 conditions, this is now a public forum effort where participants can learn more about the byway's intrinsic qualities and how byways management and other parties may position their interests in various programs for promotion, eco-tourism, preservation, and economic development of the byway area.

Interested persons are invited to express their views in writing, giving reasons for support of or in opposition to the Corridor Management Plan 2020.
