Presenter – Laura Rapp

- The Family and Community and Readiness Committee has a goal to increase housing. Different
 housing providers have provided presentations and gaps or needs; the committee can work to fill
 those gaps.
- Fentanyl Awareness Day is May 7th.
- Relevant notes to the committee from listening sessions
 - o Many misconceptions about Autism. Cultural competency training could help address this.
 - o The importance of supporting people with compassion and empathy.
 - o It is important to promote a sense belonging and mutual support.
- BHC collaborated with emerging teens at the Safe Screen Summit.
- Silence on the Streets is an upcoming event on April 30th from 6:00-7:30pm

Topic 4: Project into the Light

- Project into the Light is a national non-profit organization.
- 10 portraits of individuals who passed from drug overdose have been include in the gallery so far.

- Looking to be more inclusive and include more people of color.
- Looking at creating a large exhibit of around 50 portraits

- Looking at toolkits and resources that other states have used.
- Looking into drafting a letter for different employer organizations and how to reach out to them to start the pilot.

- Awareness raising will be pivoting towards virtual for Fentanyl Awareness Day
- Potential recovery conference, Faith forward collaborative, May 15th, 8:30am-3:00pm
