The purpose of the **PRESCRIPTION OPIOID SETTLEMENT DISTRIBUTION COMMISSION (POSDC)**, is to abate and remediate the opioid epidemic in the State of Delaware through financial support from the "Opioid Fund" in the form of grant awards in an effort to tread, prevent, and reduce opioid use disorder and the misuse of opioids.

The **BEHAVIORAL HEALTH RESOURCES COMMITTEE** has the authority to identify and to the extent possible, track the utilization of opioid-related treatment facilities and support services within the state-wide opioid treatment system; identify gaps in the state-wide opioid treatment system, through gap analyses and other means, and monitor, make recommendations and periodically report to the Commission.
