The Prescription Opioid Settlement Distribution Commission (POSDC) was established to combat the opioid crisis in Delaware by strategically utilizing funds from opioid settlements. The Commission's core purpose is to support efforts across the state that treat, prevent, and reduce opioid misuse.

The POSDC **Budget and Reporting Committee** is responsible for the financial oversight and reporting necessary to manage these funds. This includes developing and proposing annual budgets; monitoring income, expenses, and compliance with administrative spending caps; making recommendations and reporting periodically; and preparing a final annual report for the POSDC.
