The Delaware Opioid Settlement Commission (DOSC) was established to combat the opioid crisis in Delaware by using funds from the opioid settlement. The Commission's purpose is to support efforts that treat, prevent, and reduce opioid misuse across the state.

The primary purpose of the Equity Committee is to ensure equitable allocation and effective oversight of Opioid Funds. The Equity Committee collaborates with the Public Outreach and Community Input Committee and the Behavioral Health Resources Committee to analyze data and ensure fair distribution to underserved and marginalized communities. It also works with the Governance Committee to monitor award efficacy and submits periodic reports with recommendations to the DOSC and other standing committees.
